

Master Weaver Level I Supply List

Notebook/sketchbook

Pencils /Pen

Ruler

Cloth measuring tape, a quilters measuring tape

Scissors (cloth and paper)

Large blunt tapestry needle

Pencil crayons

Masking or painters tape

A ball of string

Reed hook Screwdriver, pliers and small hammer (if you have it)

4 shaft loom with a 10 or 12 dent reed (if you can)

Raddle for your loom (if you don't have a raddle, you can make one with directions below)

Shuttles and bobbins Hand bobbin winder if you have one

To make a raddle A raddle is used to spread the warp threads for beaming on the loom. It looks like a large comb, with teeth every $\frac{1}{2}$ " to 1" Have piece of 1" x 2" cut to the width of your beater. Measure across and mark in the centre of the 2" side, in $\frac{1}{2}$ inch increments. Pound 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " finishing nails in at each mark all the way across, leaving about an inch showing above the wood.
